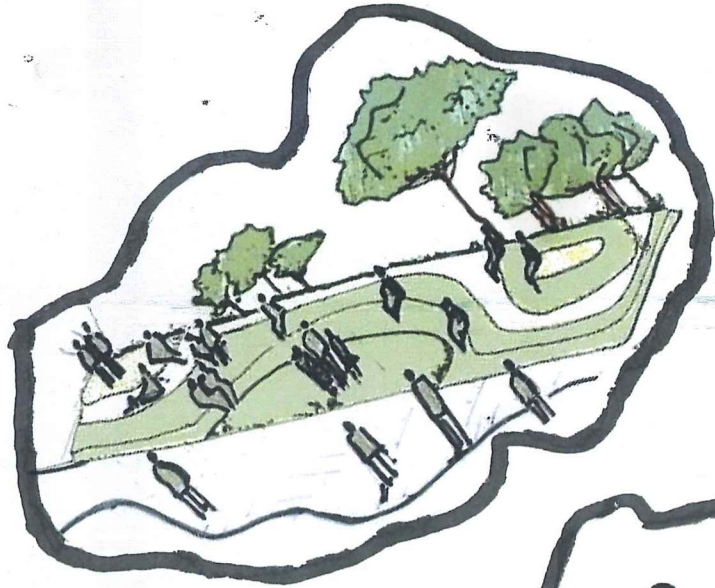

existence.

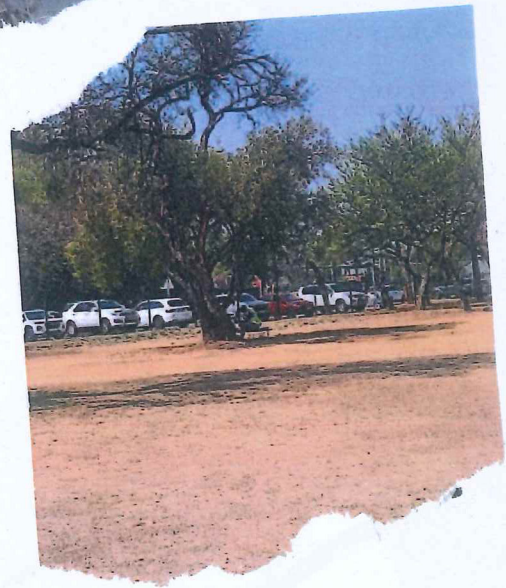
