The Science Communication Hub

The **SMUS Science Communication Hub (SC Hub)** provides a space for researchers and practitioners working on urban-related topics to develop innovative science communication projects.

In collaboration with K LAB, the communication and visualisation unit at TU Berlin's Institute for Urban and Regional Planning, the SC Hub aims to promote transdisciplinary learning and increase public engagement in addressing "Wicked Urban Problems" (WUPs) in urban spaces.

Science Communication Projects

The SMUS Science Communication Projects (SCPs) aim to deliver research outcomes and approaches to tackling WUPs in novel and/or alternative ways, beyond the classical scientific representation (e.g., via scientific papers or presentations at academic conferences). The focus lies on the communication of and on the urban, its visualisations, representations, and mediations, understanding communication not as a unidirectional presentation of information, but rather as a multidirectional dialogue.

To this end, the SCPs can deal both with the medium (or media) employed for transmitting information (e.g. maps, plans, infographics, drawings, sketches, texts, speech, audios, video), but also with the processes of transmission (e.g. human/non-human interaction, participatory methods, co-production), and questions of how a collective understanding of the corresponding content succeeds.

* While the SCPs may be produced in a language other than English, English translation should be made readily available (please remember to set aside sufficient funds for this).



Eligibility

This call is open to **all SMUS network partner institutions**. Practice-oriented partners in media and communication (e.g. designers, artists, filmmakers) and/or members of the public, civil society organisations, and other potential addressees (e.g. community organisations) can be actively involved in the content production of the projects.

Financing

Please provide a budget detailing your planned spending in the given categories (using the budget template provided).

Please note the following:

SMUS Core Partners will get paid through an Individual Work Package (IWP) contract and will have to provide both a financial and activity report before the year end (the exact deadlines will be provided in the IWP contract.

Non-Core SMUS Network Partners will receive a service contract and are not required to provide a financial report.

Application Procedure

All applications should include the following:

- 1) A PDF copy of the completed Application Form.
- 2) The completed Budget.
- 3) A signed Letter of Intent from your institution/department, confirming that it will support the SCP. In case of a partnership, each institution needs to provide an LoI.

Consideration will be given to the thematic and professional spectrum of different disciplines and the representation of the world regions within the SMUS network.
