The PEIPs have to inquire the everyday spatialities of the researched subjects

– That is, the daily orderings that the researched subjects make of the places where they live, work etc. through their bodies – both verbally and non-verbally – while making sense of their interactions with people, institutions, objects, animals, plants, etc. in these same places)

with the aid of the SMUS Toolkit

- That is, of a set of two methods of empirical qualitative research: 1) Ethnographic observation of the everyday spatialities of the researched subjects (via direct and participant observation, and go-along interviews) based, in epistemological terms, on the ethnographic attempt of simultaneously (i) making familiar what is strange and (ii) making strange what is familiar; 2) Visualization techniques of these everyday spatialities (mappings by means of drawings, photographs, sketches, etc.; or briefly, each and every technical device that
