- 5 Certified copy of Ph.D. degree*;
- 6 Transcript* of Ph.D. degree;
- 7 Proof of your advanced researcher, lecturer or professor status (only for applicants for Track B)
- 8 Scan of the information page of your passport;
- 9 A signed Letter of Invitation from the host institution. The letter of invitation should include the following information: The name of the person that is willing to mentor you during your research stay and a brief description of the host's interest in your research project. The letter of invitation should also explicitly state that you will during your stay have access to a desk /working area, library access and other potential resources will be made available to you in order for you to conduct your research. Please note that a so-called "desk fee" will not be covered by the scholarship;
